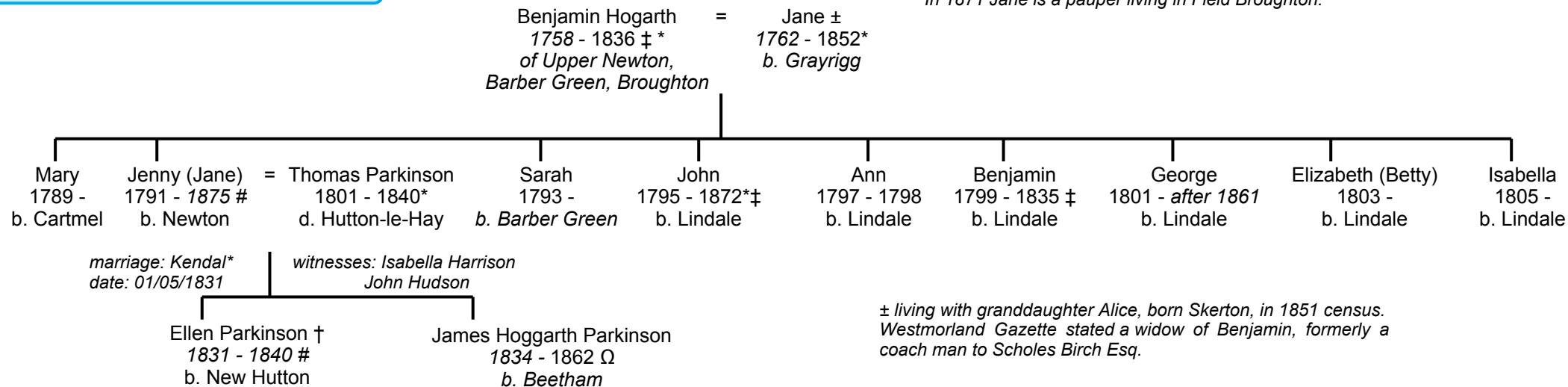

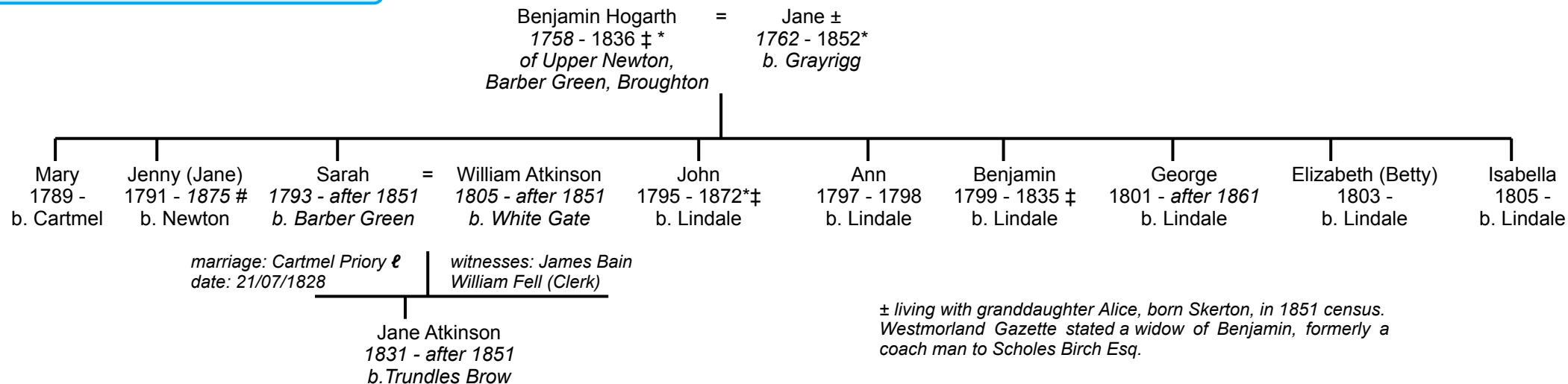
Upon their marriage both Jane and Thomas are said to be of Hutton in Hay parish.
In 1841 Jane is a bread maker living in Stricklandgate with her son James.
In 1861 James is a carter residing with his Aunt Sarah Parkinson in Highgate.
In 1871 Jane is a pauper living in Field Broughton.
