Following the death of Rowland in 1860, the 1861 census records his daughter Margaret farming 17 acres at Pool House, Low Gill, Dillicar along with her younger siblings and John Lee, a twenty year old Uncle, disabled by an accident.

In 1871 Margaret Ellis is living with her son-in-law and daughter (Thomas and Margaret Bracken) and their family at Broad Gate, Sedbergh. Husband George Ellis is farming 50 acres in Sedbergh. Three Hoggarth step children are with him: John, Robert, Eleanor. John is assisting with the farming. In 1881 Margaret Ellis, a labourer's wife, is a visitor at Gateside, Sedbergh to John and Agnes Bracken. Agnes is her elder sister, born Cartmel 1803. In 1891 Margaret is living with her brewer's labourer husband, George, in Castle Street, Kendal.


In 1901 George, widower, is living with his granddaughter Margaret in Yard 4. Wildman Street, Kendal. She is his housekeeper.

In 1907 this granddaughter marries Edward Nelson, one of a family of


