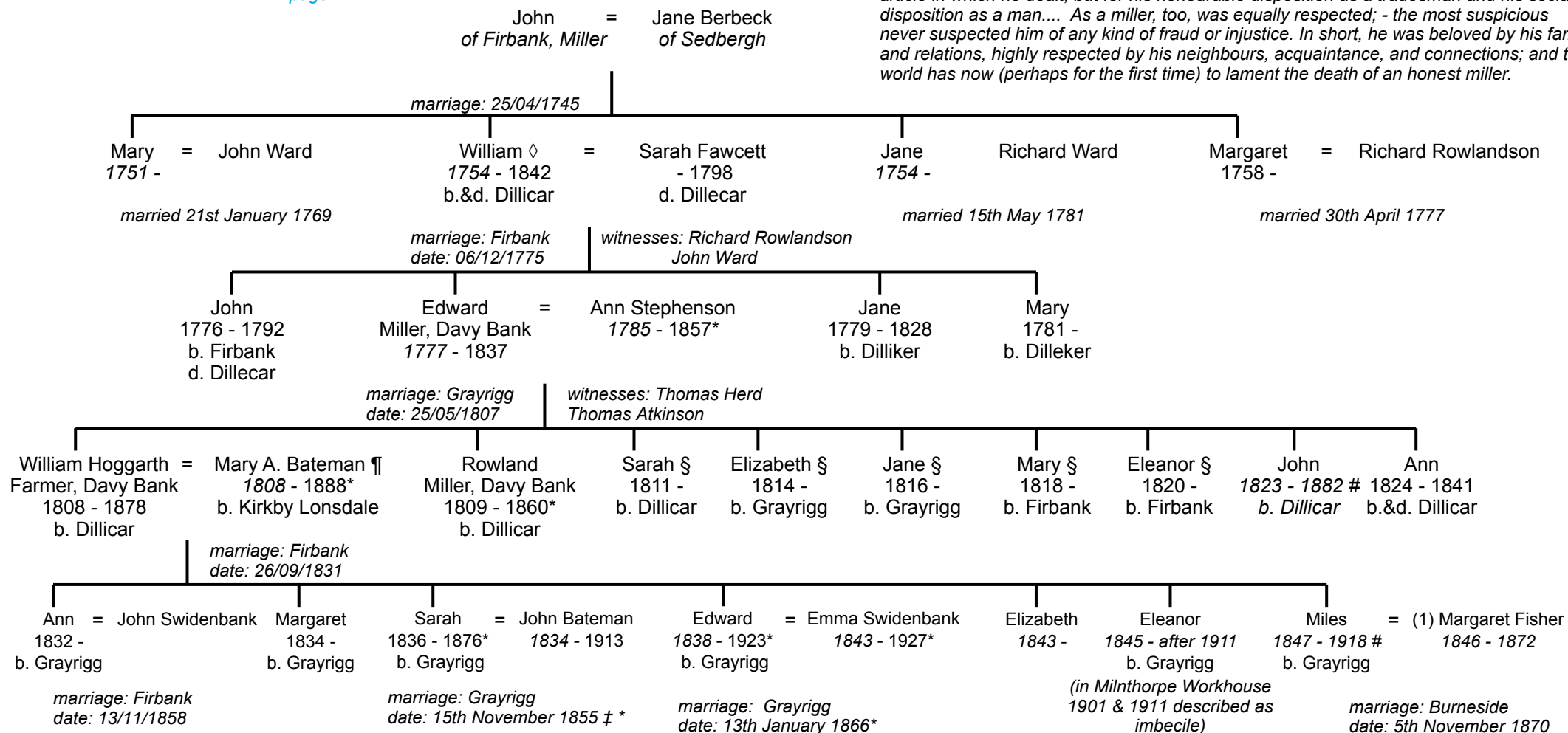


◇ Manchester Courier and Lancashire General Advertiser - 7th May 1842
On Saturday last, **Old William Hoggarth**, of Dillicar Mill, in Dillicar, aged 88 years. William from his youth up was miller and maltster. As a maltster he was highly respected by all the landlords in the towns of Kendal, Sedbergh, and Dent, not only for the excellence of the article in which he dealt, but for his honourable disposition as a tradesman and his social disposition as a man.... As a miller, too, was equally respected; - the most suspicious never suspected him of any kind of fraud or injustice. In short, he was beloved by his family and relations, highly respected by his neighbours, acquaintance, and connections; and the world has now (perhaps for the first time) to lament the death of an honest miller.

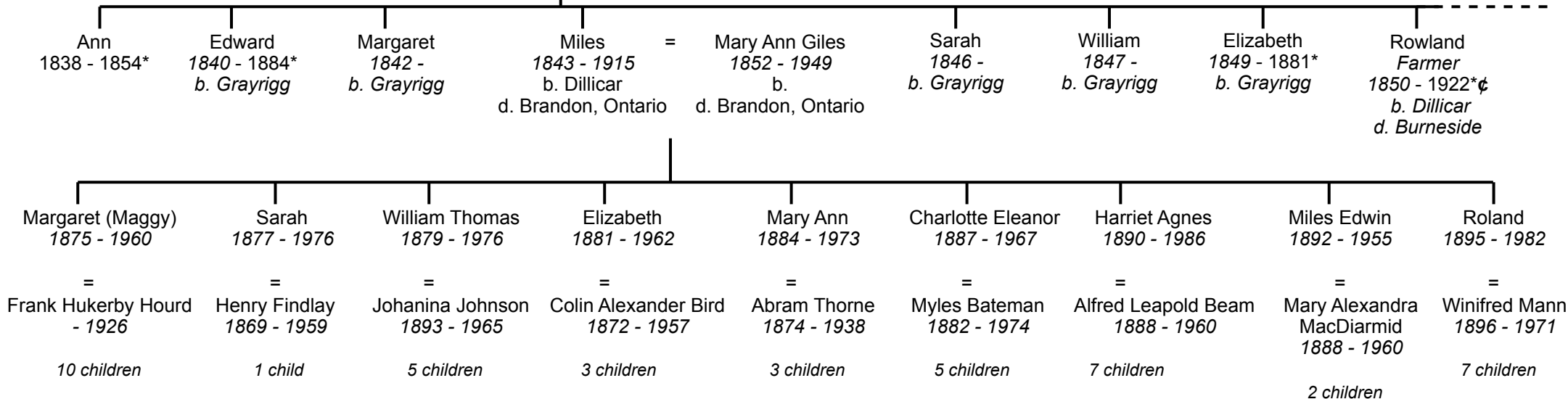
Following the death of Rowland in 1860, the 1861 census records his daughter Margaret farming 17 acres at Pool House, Low Gill, Dillicar along with her younger siblings and John Lee, a twenty year old Uncle, disabled by an accident. Margaret married Thomas Bracken in 1864. In the Canadian 1881 census Robert is a cabinet maker living in Ontario with James Bracken, brother of Thomas. James seems to have emigrated on the same ship Sarmatian in February 1881
