◊ The author of *Echoes from years gone by* &c. Said to be the eldest of seven children. His father was the youngest and only son of the three children of Thomas Hoggarth who [supposedly] was born in the Vale of Troutbeck and related to the Woodburne and Birkett families.

James' father at around the time of his birth lived near to Wordsworth with whom he had "many pleasant conversations". His father was a "good scholar and excellent mathematician having been educated at Longsleddale, Grayrigg, and Kentmere schools". [In 1871 Thomas appears to be lodged in the Kendal Union Workhouse.]

When 8 years old James attended Helsington School and subsequently apprenticed to Robert Seed of Oak Bank as a bobbin turner. In 1891 James is living in Stricklandgate "Bobbin turner unable to work". His brother Thomas became a mole catcher in Wales and Jacob in 1891 was a bookkeeper in Endmoor.

Jacob is at the Works Lodge, Gatebeck, when his wife died.

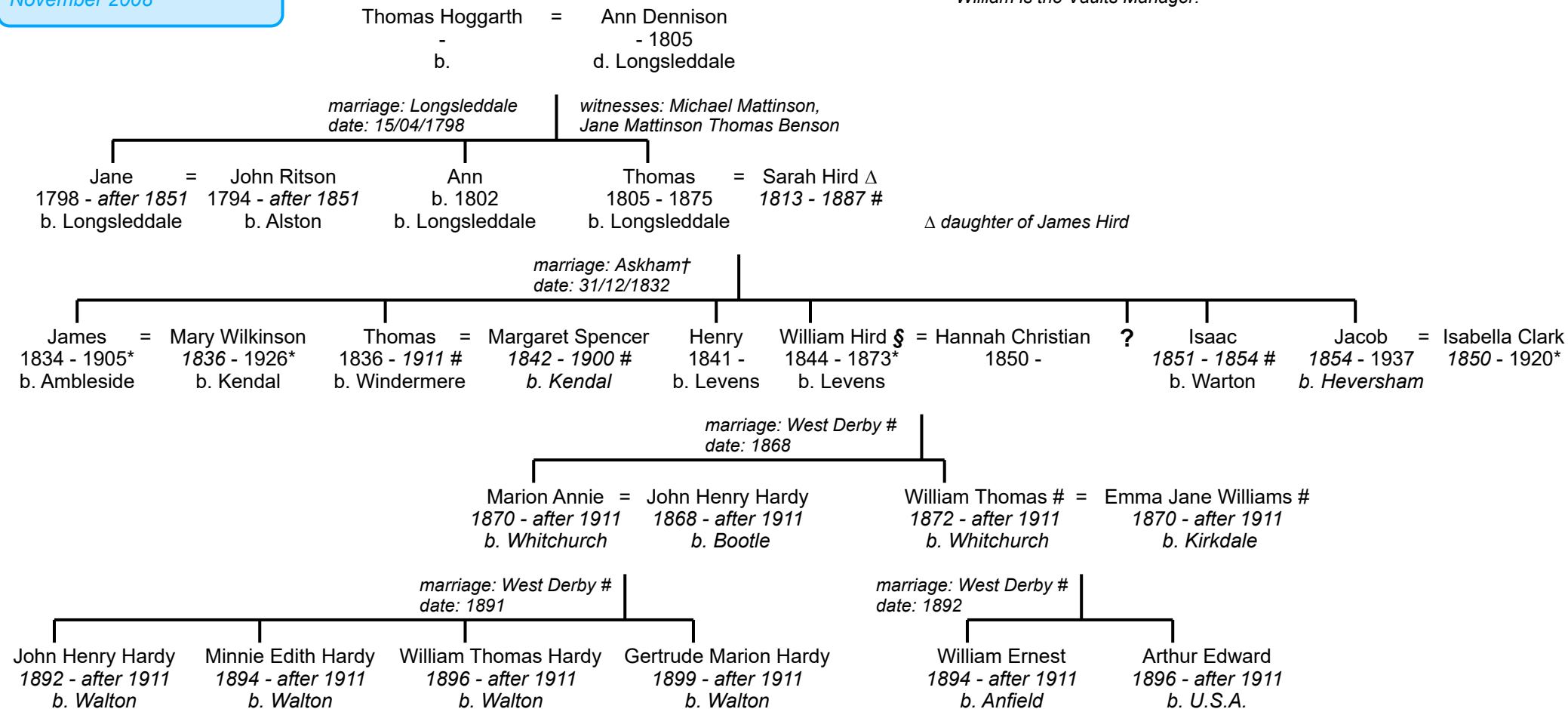
