


# Lancaster Hoggarths



In 1841 Christopher and Agnes are living in Brock Street of independent means. Christopher was living in Brook Street, Lancaster upon the death of his wife. In 1851 the widowed Christopher is a proprietor of houses.

 In 1841 Duncan and Margaret McArthur are living in Chester Street, Toxteth Park, West Derby. Duncan is a merchant. Thomas and William are living with them.  
 In 1851 Margaret McArthur is an annuitant living with her children in Prospect Vale, West Derby.  
 In 1871 Margaret McArthur is living in Kensington, West Derby, with her four sons.  
 In 1881 John Williams McArthur is living at Lathom, Ormskirk. John, a retired shipowner, had married a widow in 1873 who had brought several children into the marriage  
 In 1891 the widowed Sarah Ann is living on own means in Birkenhead. Her daughter Margaret E., born 1876, is living with her as is James McArthur, her brother in law, and two of his children.





In 1841 John is living in Rosemary Lane, Lancaster, and is described as a Master Mariner.  
In 1841 Thomas, a druggist, along with his brother, is lodging with the family of Duncan Mc Arthur, Chester Street, Toxteth, West Derby.  
In 1851 John is living at Chapel Row, listed as a widower, and living with his widowed daughter-in-law, Isabella. Margaret Atkinson is widowed and living in West Derby. There are four children, two of whom were born in Scotland.  
In 1851 Thomas and Elizabeth are living in Pythian Street, West Derby. Thomas is a chemist. Also present is Thomas' mother, a retired mariner's wife.  
In 1871 Thomas and Elizabeth are living at Walton Lane, Kirkdale, West Derby. Living with them is cousin Henry H. Holmes, born Lancaster @ 1854  
In 1881 Thomas and Elizabeth are living at 48 Onslow Road, West Derby. Thomas is a retired chemist. Sister-in-law, Maria Hughes, single, is living with them.  
In 1891 Thomas and Elizabeth are still living in Onslow Road.


In 1841 John is living in Rosemary Lane, Lancaster, and is described as a Master Mariner.

In 1861 the recently widowed Ellen Jane is living with her family in Lilley Road, West Derby. She is a landed proprietress. Also living in are a nephew and niece. John William McArthur is a ship owner at the age of 23!

Ellen Jane married a second time to a Doctor of medicine. They had a son, Charles Edward Lister, who was baptised at Knotty Ash in 1864.
