





± probable daughter of Thomas and Eleanor. In the 1841 census Thomas is a farmer at Beathwaite Green △ Henry did not emigrate with his mother and brothers but several years later. He was a shoemaker and postmaster. He and Agnes lived and died in Scarborough, a suburb of Toronto.

The fact that Henry was a shoemaker may explain his late departure. He would have had to complete his apprenticeship.




△ Daniel married Elizabeth Ann Elford on 7 Jan 1840 in Darlington they had 5 sons and 9 daughters
