

In 1851 only Elizabeth and John were at home along with two Stuart grandchildren. Son Henry had recently died.


Father & son along with widow Elizabeth were living in Urswick in 1871.


By 1901 son John and widow and housekeeper Elizabeth were living at 43 Dale Street in Ulverston. The Johns appear to have been labourers all their working lives.



He had a twin brother, Daniel, who died before the year was out.


