

∆ It is likely that Agnes had illegitimate children before her marriage to John Ellwood - see Kendal Borough Hoggarths


Tony Cousins writes:

"The Skelsmergh Vestry book has a November 1820 entry requesting Robert Dockray should write to his brother near Carlisle to enquire after John Graham a weaver at Black Dykes in Kirklington, Cumberland who had a child affiliated upon him by Agnes Hoggart in Skelsmergh who had not paid expenses or maintenance towards the child in spite of a March 18, 1815 order.

There is a copy of the order that named the child as John born on Feb 11, 1815 to Agnes Hoggart single woman.

On March 5, 1823 there is a letter from a John Bell respecting John Hoggarth, a bastard child of Agnes Hoggarths by John Graham, about John being bound as a parish apprentice to him.

On November 12, 1823 it is stated that Agnes Hoggarth daughter of Wm Hoggarth now living at Garth Row was with child and she was ordered to quit the township. I take this to mean she had been living elsewhere for some time and the Vestry was anxious that she should not be allowed settlement."





Ada Newton 1900 - after 1919 b. Portsmouth




