In 1851 Barbara Farrer, who ten years earlier had been a House Servant to Henry and Mary and their young family in Kendal, is housekeeper to Henry's eldest brother, the widowed William Hoggarth, aged 50, and his son, Henry, aged 20, born Selside. They are living at Garthrow in Skelsmergh where William's parents William and Agnes had recently died.

By 1861 The widowed William has re-married and is living with his second wife and two daughters by her at Waterson Ground near to Hawkshead. They also have John William, Henry's infant son, in their care. (There are reports in the Lancaster Guardian for 1860 & 1861 that Henry Hoggarth of Coniston was in court for insolvency). It is this John William who later marries Henry's granddaughter Mary.

‡ Servant to her aunt Mary Waddington in Padiham in 1861. James Waddington's sister, Elizabeth, married Joseph Crook in 1835. William Henry was their son.

** farm servant to his Uncle John in 1841, and Uncle Edward Martindale in 1851. He married in 1859 Hannah Liddel Jackson, 1834 - 1915; first daughter, Mary, born 1860.

§ Eleanor, daughter of William and Elizabeth Simm, originally from Firbank and Orton, remarried on Christmas Day 1845* to William Chambley of Natland. In the 1851 Census Mary Hoggarth is listed as a step daughter. Her brother, William Simm farmed at Bouthwaite.

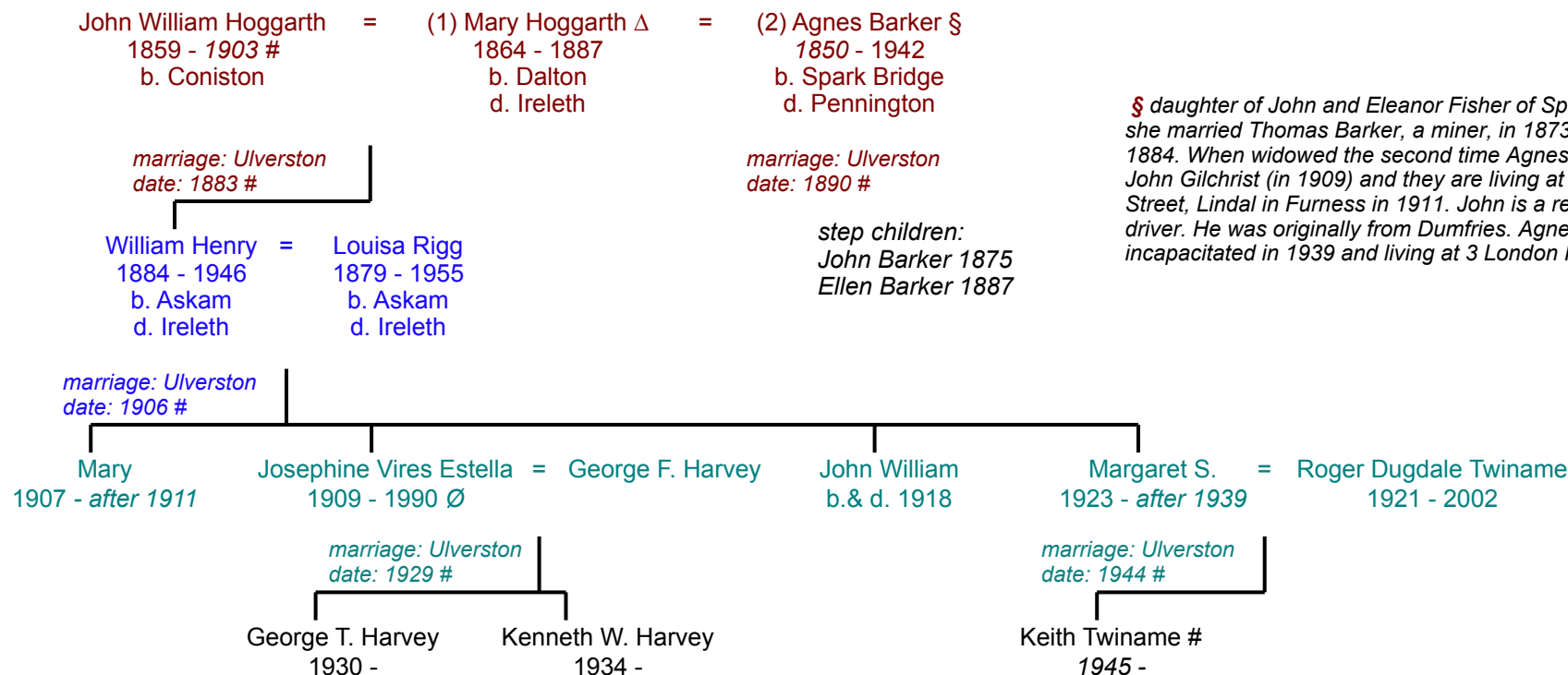
