In 1861 **James Sandham** is an iron miner. He, his wife, and baby daughter are living at Green Lane Cottages, Pennington, next door to William and Margaret. In 1881 James Agnes and family are living in Chapel Street, Dalton. James is a miner as are the two eldest sons and his son-in-law William Atkinson. In 1891 **Margaret Ann Atkinson** is living in Lancaster Street, Dalton with her children, also siblings Thomas and Robert, who are miners, and Agnes.



On November 9th 1893 Margaret Ann Atkinson and her children sailed aboard Drummond Castle from Southampton aboard the vessel Drummond Castle bound for Cape Town, South Africa. It is likely her husband, siblings and parents had gone before.

The Drummond Castle was wrecked on a return voyage from South Africa in 1896. All passengers and crew were lost except for three survivors

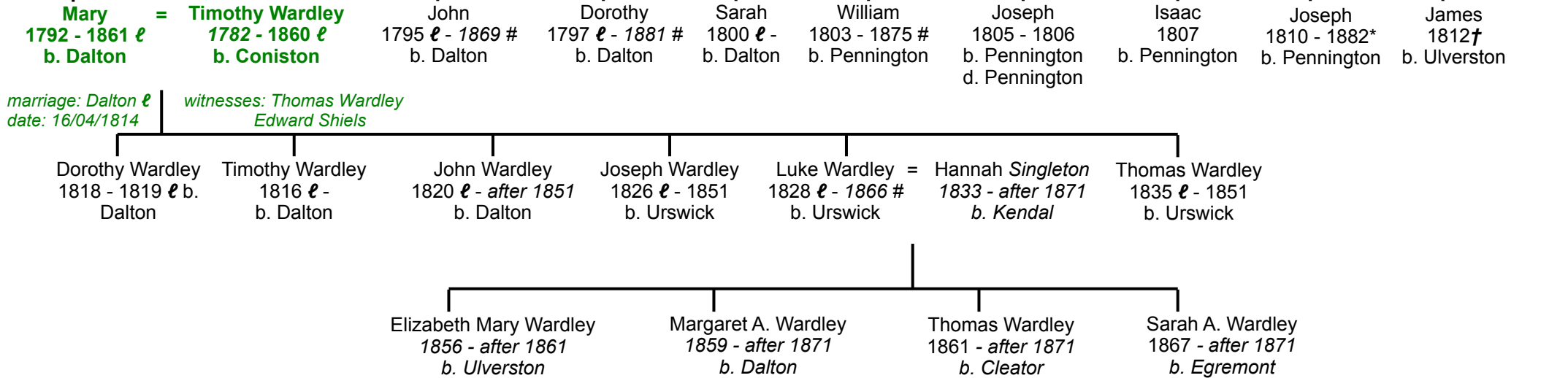

 1911 James and Elizabeth are living at Home Bank. Only Edward is at home.

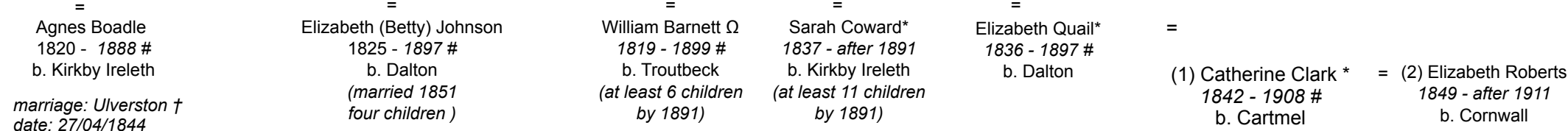
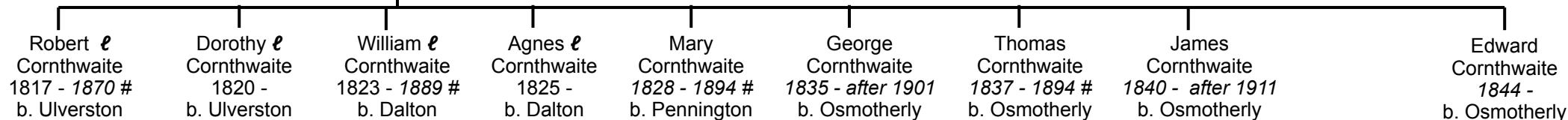

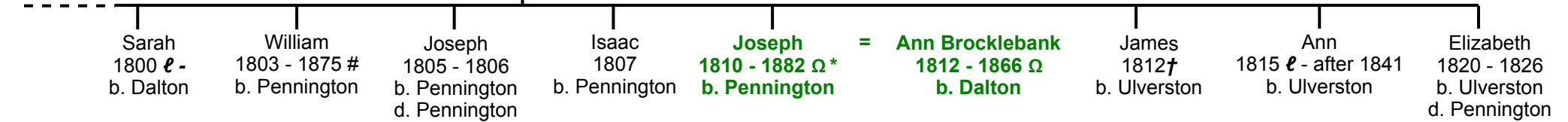
Upon his daughter Dorothy's death in 1857, Joseph is said in the Ulverston Advertiser to be a miner at Marton .

William Sandham is living in Sharp Street, Askam, in 1906 £, the same street as William Henry Hoggarth. His aunt and uncle, William and Margaret, are living at 35 Steel Street.

In 1891 Grandson Joseph is living with his wife and child near Cockermouth. He is an engine fitter. By 1911 they have eight children, all alive, and Joseph is a waterworks engineer (Manchester Corporation). In 1939 Joseph and his wife are retired and living in Ulverston.

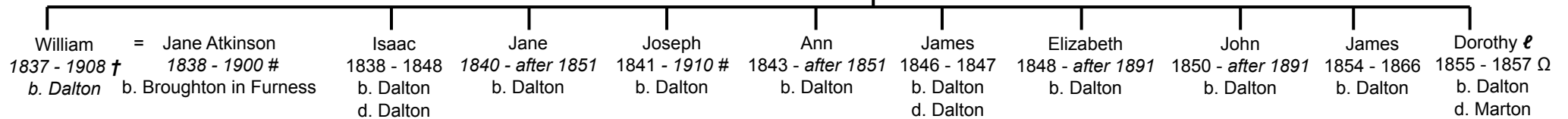

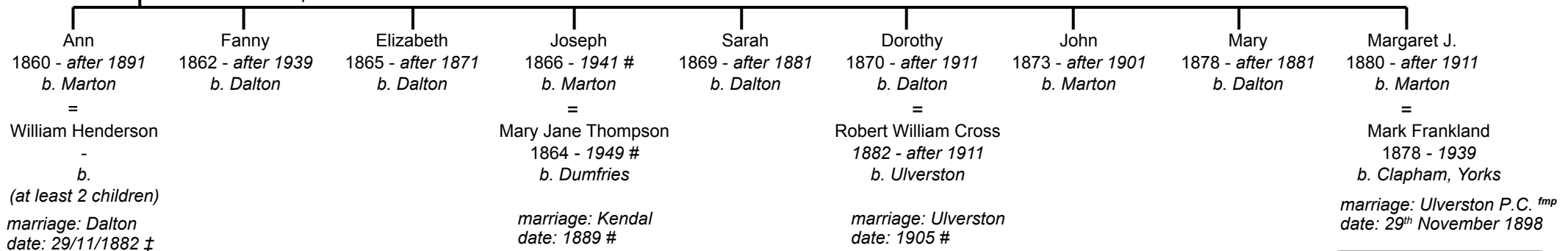

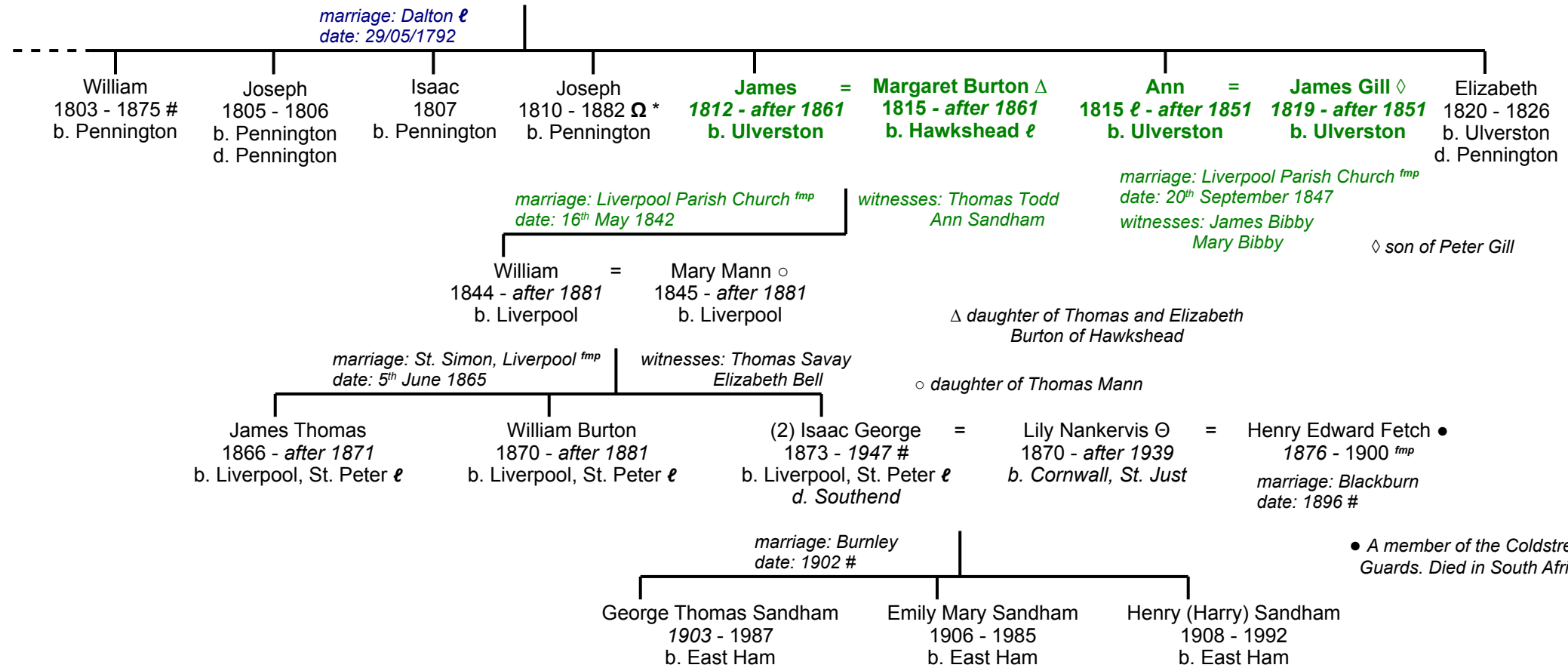

Bigger would have been a hamlet towards the south end of Walney

Ormsgill would have been a hamlet near to the coast opposite the north end of Walney

Northscale was a hamlet towards the north end of Walney

Loppergarth (Pennington) is midway between Lindal and Ulverston

Hastygill is west of Ulverston possibly close to Rosshhead. Levy Beck flowed through it (which lower down becomes Dragley Beck)

Rosshhead Nook is about a mile west of Ulverston in the same vicinity, if not the same as, Hastygill

Tyteup Farmhouse is about a mile to the west of Lindal

Highgreaves lies between Rosshhead and Pennington (Loppergarth)

Whinfield is a short distance from Lindal towards Pennington

Lowfield House lay in Green Lane between Swarthmoor and Lindal

Tarnflatt is at Marton between Lindal and Ireleth. It is interesting to note that Robert Graves (son of Robert Graves & Marion Hoggarth) and his wife Catherine were living here in 1829.
