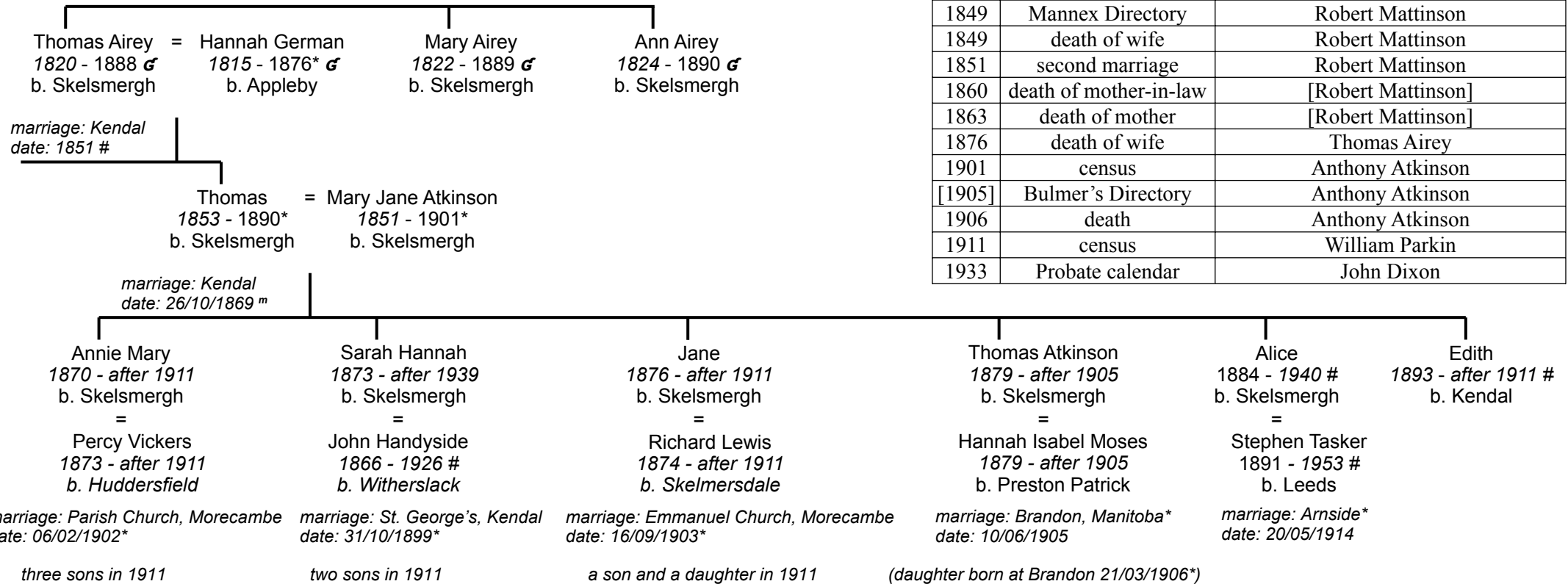


## Aireys of Selside Hall

Hannah's was a second marriage. In 1871 there was a stepson, James German (b.@1845), living at Selside Hall. In 1891 the widowed Mary Jane was farming at Selside Hall. By 1901 it was in the hands of Anthony Atkinson whose second wife was a great granddaughter of the Martindales who farmed at Selside Hall early in the century - **see Agnes Hoggarth born 1796, also Martindales.**
