




1802 Isaac Bristo died at Blackatbottom


Westmorland Gazette - Death 18th November 1826 "On Monday last, at Mirehead, in Grayrigg, John Farrer, aged 44, one of the Society of Friends. He was an active and spirited man – a cheerful and benevolent neighbour – a man of candour, and could not be prejudiced by any views of interest. He was confined to his bed upwards of eight months, which he bore with becoming patience and resignation."




