


James Lewis 1893 - after 1911 b. Dalton (grandson)





At the time of his marriage John Wood is recorded as from Cowmire Hall. In 1851 John is an agricultural labourer living at Raw Lyth; Thomas & Isabella Lewis are a near neighbour. In 1861 John is farming at Grassgarth where his father-in-law, James Lewis, had previously farmed. By 1871 he is farming at Hubbersty Head



Ann is possibly the illegitimate daughter of Sarah Lewis. No baptism record found. In 1841 census Ann is listed beneath Daniel Lewis for whom there is a baptism record showing him to be the illegitimate son of Sarah.

Family search index records baptismal record for Maria in October 1863 as daughter of Eleanor, but clearly stated to be Ann's daughter in 1881 census.
