[&]quot;In Barre, October 6th 1855, Mr. John Mattinson, aged 49. Mr. Mattinson was a native of Westmorland, England, and emigrated to this country [i.e. America] in the spring of 1811[sic – probably 1841], and settled on the farm where he died. He was a man possessed of many virtues, and highly esteemed in the neighbourhood where he resided. He had been for several years a Warden of the Episcopal church in Albion, and was always zealous in good works for the upbuilding of the Redeemer's kingdom. He has gone to rest – Orleans, America (New York paper)"
