 In 1901 the couple are back in Warsash, Hampshire



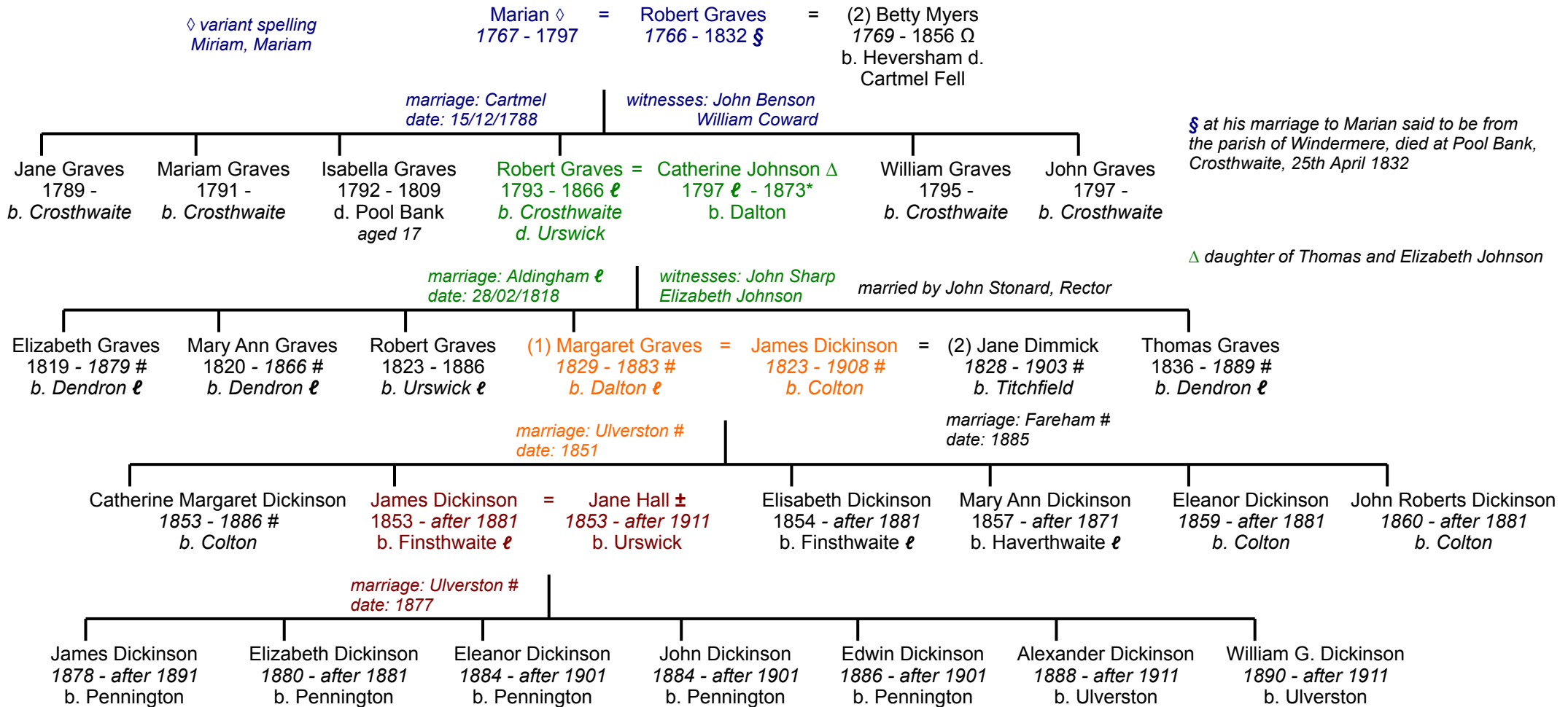

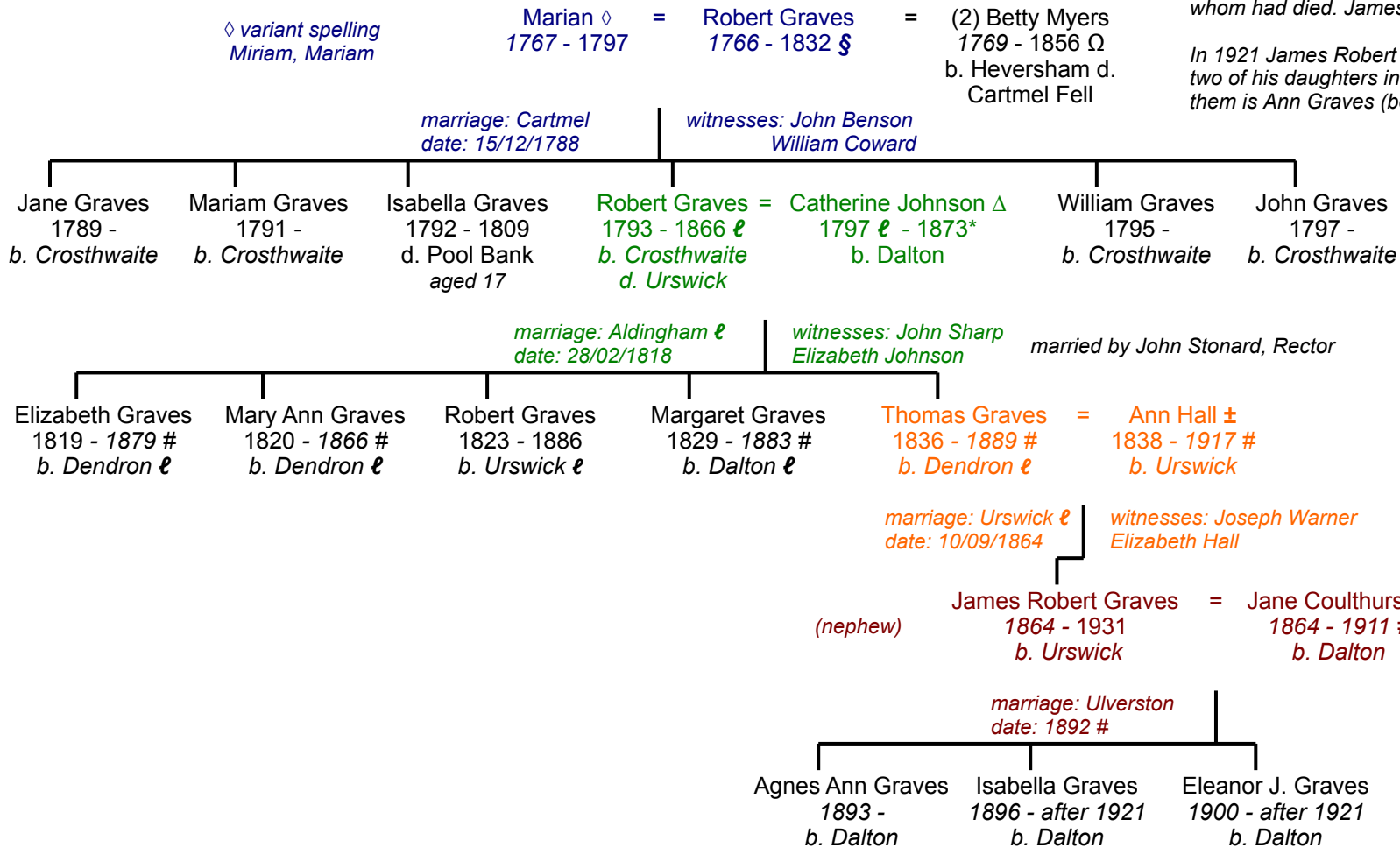

The 1871 & 1881 census say that James Robert is nephew to Thomas, from 1891 he is listed as son to the widowed Ann.

In 1901 James Robert is living with his young family at 22 Queen Street in Dalton. He is a miner's labourer. The widowed Ann is head of the family.

The 1911 Census reveals James Robert & Jane had four children, one of whom had died. James Robert is out of work.

In 1921 James Robert is widowed and out of work from Vickers living with two of his daughters in Queen Street, Dalton-in-Furness, Also living with them is Ann Graves (born Urswick @1844) his mother.



From Probate Calendar:

James Robert Graves of 22 Queen-street Dalton-in-Furness Lancashire died 24 December 1931 Probate London 8 January to Stanley Joseph Fisher solicitor and Alfred Brown solicitor's clerk. Effects £54 19s.
